CHOOSE FROM 5 NATIONAL FIRE ACADEMY COURSES:

1. **Incident Command System for Structural Collapse:** This course is designed to provide an understanding of response, needed resources, operations, etc... at an incident. **(16 hours)**
Class size: 30. Audience: Fire officers & personnel serving in a Unified Command structure.
2. **Introduction to Wildland/Urban Interface for Structural Fire Officers:** This course identifies activities & safety concerns at an Interface incident. **(14 1/2 hours)** **Class size 30.** Audience: Chief officers, company officers, those aspiring to be promoted & senior firefighters.
3. **Leadership III: Strategies for Supervisory Success:** This course covers the basic skills and techniques needed to improve command effectiveness. **(12 hours)** **Class size: 30.** Audience: Line officers, training officers, individuals preparing for promotions.
4. **Prevention/Mitigation Advocacy for Small Department Responders:** This course covers fire prevention, mitigation awareness, and motivation for those who have been focused on responding. **(13 hours)** **Class size: 30.** Audience: All personnel interested in fire prevention.
5. **Strategy & Tactics for Initial Company Operations:** This course covers the Communications Model, Quick Access Prefire Plan and the Command sequence at a structure fire. **(15 hours)**
Class size: 30 Audience: Company officers, those seeking a promotion and senior firefighters.
